Electronics Recycling Drive-Through Drop-Off Days for 2022 at the Cincinnati Recycling & Reuse Hub with fees

The Cincinnati Recycling & Reuse Hub will hold electronics recycling drop-off events on September 10 and October 15 the remainder of this year. All events are on Saturdays from 10 AM - 2 PM at the Hub warehouse, 911 Evans Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, but enter the parking lot from Woodrow Street. If you are unable to attend the events, electronics are also accepted during regular Hub business hours.

Residents from all areas of the Tri-State are encouraged to attend. All electronic items, including household appliances, computers and all accessories, and more will be accepted, with the exception of biohazardous items, such as glucose meters, and household hazardous waste items, like thermostats that contain mercury. Items, like TVs, computer monitors, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, batteries, light bulbs, and smoke detectors require fees to cover disposal costs for the hazardous waste components of those items. For all other items, there is a fee of \$10 per vehicle. Cash payment is preferred, but credit card payments are also an option. RecycleForce, a non-profit from Indianapolis, will de-manufacture items and shred all hard drives to address any privacy concerns. The plastics, glass, and metals are then sold to build new items, while all toxic elements, such as lead and mercury, are disposed of properly to avoid environmental contamination.

The Hub is a 501(c)(3) non-profit made up almost entirely of volunteers who want to increase reuse and recycling rates for the Greater Cincinnati Area. Donations to the Hub help cover operational expenses so that they can continue to provide services to the community.
